His resonant and visual language includes video work, photography, performative, and installative practices, all of which bear the signs of Pappas’ anthropological and phenomenological approach toward his subjects. He was born on the island of Patmos, he lives and works in Berlin.

Henry Hu

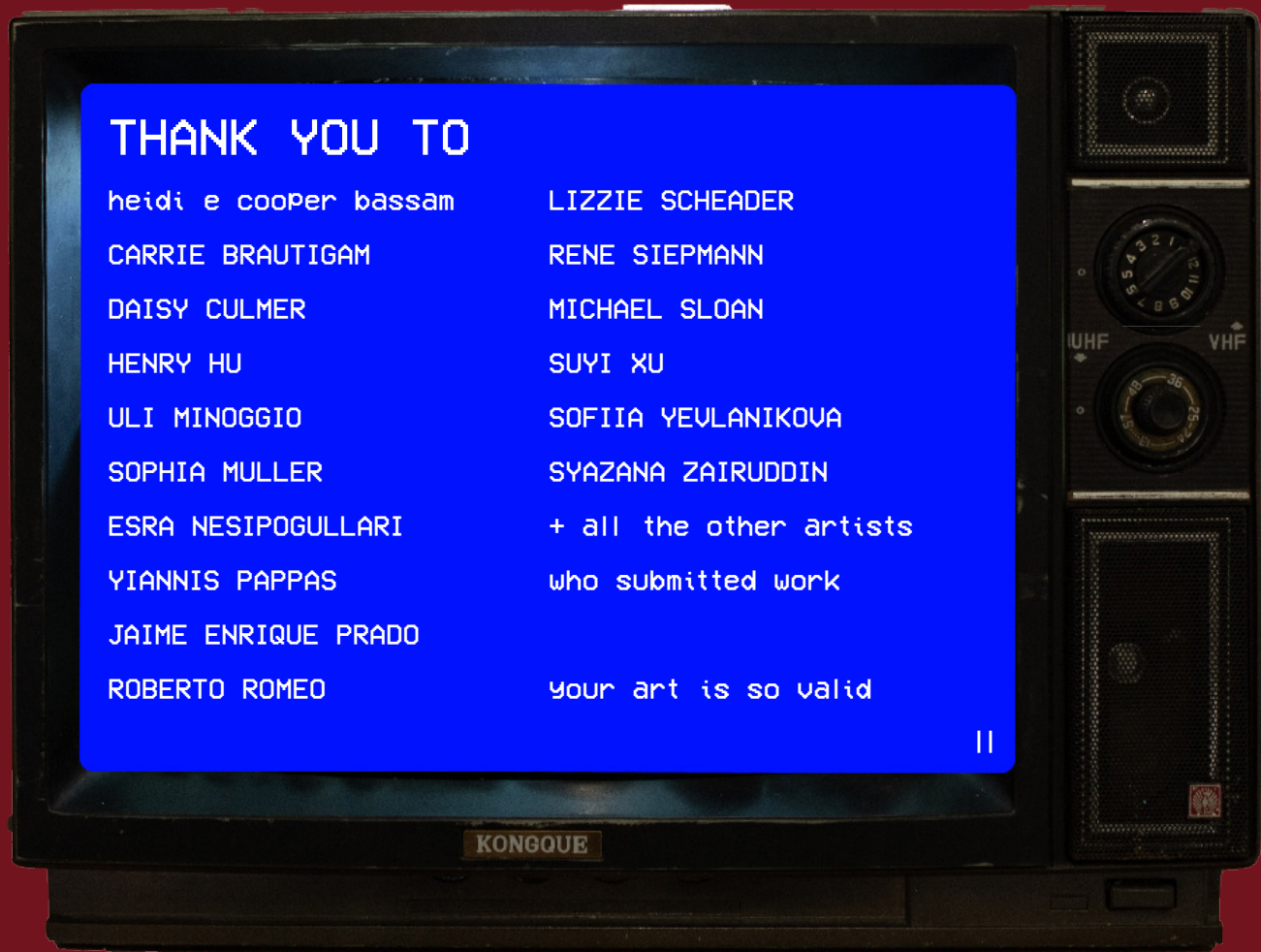
